At Golden Flatts Primary School we are committed to every child reaching their full potential as a learner and a citizen of our school. We are acutely aware that all children have different strengths and interests, learn in different ways and will excel in different areas. Our commitment to quality first teaching ensures that we strive continuously to meet the needs of all children within the classroom. There are however occasions when children need additional or extra support to be the best they can be.

What will we do if your child needs extra support?

First, we will discuss any concerns with you, the parents/guardians, and can include the children in this if it is appropriate. We will find out what is causing the barrier and come up with a plan to address them. We will then agree a plan (Individual Education Plan) that outlines the support your child will receive, who it will be provided by and set clear targets. We will also set a review date (usually the following term) to assess the progress your child has made towards the targets and the effectiveness of the support provided. From there we set new targets and adjust the provision accordingly to ensure ongoing success in learning and progress across the curriculum.

In some cases, it may be decided that we need additional/specific information and/support from outside agencies to ensure we are providing the very best support. A list of agencies we liaise with regularly is listed below:

- Educational Psychologist*
- Support teacher*
- Speech and language therapist*
- Hearing impaired service

- Occupational therapist

- The HUB
